YES NO Lewis Central Education Foundation Scholarship – Five, \$1,000 one-time scholarships will be awarded.

Criteria:

- Graduating in May 2020
- Four of these scholarships will go to students continuing their education at a 2- or 4-year college
- One scholarship will go to a student attending Career and Technical school or program

YES NO Robert Humphrey Memorial Scholarship – Five, \$1,000 one-time scholarships will be awarded.

Criteria:

- Graduating in May 2020
- Top 50% of class and holding approximately a 3.0 average
- School and community involvement (church activities, community groups, awards, honors, etc.)
- Leadership (club offices, team captains, etc.)
- Academic performance (ACT, class rank, GPA, other awards, etc.)
- Extra-curricular activities (clubs, athletics, music, etc.)
- Volunteer experience
- Personal interview may be given to top candidates

YES NO Steven L. Clark Scholarship – Renewable \$1,000 scholarship for four years for a total of \$4,000 will be awarded.

Criteria:

- **MALE** graduating in May 2020
- Must be pursuing a college education in the field of **engineering**
- In order to maintain the scholarship from year to year, the student must show evidence of continuing in the field of engineering or business administration and maintain a college GPA of 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale.
- Must attach a paragraph stating 5 and 10-year goals
- Must provide a copy of his college transcript to the Foundation prior to the next year's payment

YES NO Diane Wiese Clark Scholarship – *Renewable \$1,000 scholarship for four years for a total of \$4,000 will be awarded.*

Criteria:

- **FEMALE** graduating in May 2020
- Must be pursuing a college education in the field of **business administration** or related business degree such as accounting, finance, etc.
- In order to maintain the scholarship from year to year, the student must show evidence of continuing in the field of business administration and maintain a college GPA of 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale.
- Must attach a paragraph stating 5 and 10-year goals
- Must provide a copy of her college transcript to the Foundation prior to the next year's payment

YES NO Kevin Reedy Memorial Scholarship – *\$1,000 annual award*

Criteria:

- 2020 LC Senior with 2.0 or greater GPA
- Must be pursuing further education no later than the fall of 2020 (trade, junior, or 4-year college)
- Highest priority given to student who has been active in volunteering with school and/or community

YES NO Leroy C. Brown Scholarship – *Amount and number of scholarships vary, but a one-time scholarship of approximately \$300 will be awarded.*

Criteria:

- Graduating in May 2020
- Pursuing any type of higher education

YES NO Donna Hearty Memorial Scholarship – *\$1,000 one-time scholarship will be awarded.*

Criteria:

- Graduating in May 2020
- Pursuing any type of higher education in the fall after graduation
- Active in one or more school and/or community activities during high school

YES NO Zella Duchman Scholarship – *\$1,000 one-time scholarship will be awarded.*

Criteria:

- Graduating in May 2020
- Pursuing education for accounting, or other business-related career
- Must attach a paragraph about a time where you gave back or paid it forward. Be sure to explain how this experience changed you.

YES NO James Fuller and Larry Wilwerding Wrestling Scholarship – *number and amount of one-time scholarships will vary as determined by the current head coach and scholarship administrators. A \$1000, one-time scholarship will be awarded in 2020.*

Criteria:

- Graduating in May 2020
- Wrestled at least one complete season for Lewis Central High School
- Must attach a paragraph about the lifelong lessons you will take with you because you have been an LC wrestler

YES NO Susan and Ron Stazzoni Vocational Scholarship – *\$1,000 one-time scholarship. (A vocational school is an 8 to 24 month college that provides mostly employment-preparation skills for trained labor related to a specific job such as welding, culinary arts, construction, auto, HVAC, etc.)*

Criteria:

- Education must be directed at a specific skills based career
- The course must be an 8 to 24 month accredited program with ending certification.
- Funds will be distributed after first term classes are completed and passing grades achieved.

YES NO Margaret Kilibarda Memorial Scholarship – *Two \$1,500 scholarships: One to a student majoring in elementary education; the other, to a student majoring in secondary education.*

Criteria:

- Graduating in May 2020
- Top 50 percent of class
- Involvement and leadership in school and community activities will be heavily weighted
- Must attach a short essay (250 words maximum) describing what inspires you to pursue a career in teaching
- Upon entering college, \$750 will be awarded to the college the recipient is attending; and upon providing the Foundation with verification of beginning student teaching, the second \$750 will go directly to the recipient to support expenses while student teaching
