# Criteria for Lewis Central Foundation Scholarships

## **Foundation Scholarships**

Amount: \$750 one time...there are five to be awarded.

Application deadline on or before **March 15, 2013**

The five (5) scholarships will be in the amount of \$500 (one time). Four of these scholarships will go to students continuing their education at a 2 or 4 year college. One scholarship will go to a student attending Career and Technical school.

## **Robert L. Humphrey Scholarship**

Amount: \$1,000 (one time)...there are 5.

Application deadline on or before **March 15, 2013**

The five (5) scholarships will be in the amount of \$1,000 (one time). The purpose of the scholarship is to assist a senior from Lewis Central High School in his or her endeavor to continue their education. If a student is considering continuing their education, whether it be for college, vocational or technical training, they are encouraged to apply for the scholarships. The following criteria and factors will be considered in awarding the scholarship:

- School and community involvement (Church activities community groups, awards, honors, etc)
- Leadership (club offices, team captains, etc)
- Academic performance (ACT or SAT, class rank, GPA, other awards, etc) Please note that students who are in the top 50% of their class and holding approximately a 3.0 average are encouraged to apply. Academic performance will not be given greater weight than any other criteria.
- Extra-curricular activities (clubs, athletics, music, etc)
- Volunteer experience (Please provide recommendation from supervisors or employers.)
- Unique or unusual circumstances (number of siblings, unusual family situations, personal circumstances, etc)
- Statement of aspirations of goals (Each applicant should submit a statement setting out their aspirations and goals. The statement should be at least two full paragraphs.)
- Personal interview (After the initial applications are reviewed, finalists will be selected to attend a personal interview.)

## **Fiscus Family Scholarship**

Amount: \$600 (one time) - \$200 at beginning of college and \$400 during student teaching semester.

There are 4 of these scholarships.

Application deadline on or before **March 15, 2013**

Four (4) \$600 scholarships will be awarded to seniors majoring in the field of education at a college/university. Upon entering college the recipient will receive \$200 and at the time they begin student teaching the remaining amount, \$400, will be distributed upon notification from the student of such information.

### **Steve Clark Scholarship**

Amount: \$4,000 @ \$1000/year.

Application deadline on or before **March 15, 2013**

This scholarship will be in the amount of \$4,000.00 (\$1000.00 per year for 4 years). The purpose of the scholarship is to assist a male senior from Lewis Central High School in his endeavor to continue his higher education in the field of engineering or business administration. If a male student is considering continuing his education at a four year college or university, in the area of engineering or business administration, he is encouraged to apply for this scholarship. In order to maintain the scholarship from year to year, the student must show evidence of continuing in the field of engineering or business administration. And maintain a GPA of 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale. The student must provide a copy of their transcript to the Foundation prior to the next year's payment.

### **Diane Wiese Clark Scholarship**

Amount: \$4,000 @ \$1000/year

Application deadline on or before **March 15, 2013** purpose of the scholarship is to assist a female senior from Lewis Central High School in her endeavor to continue her higher education in the field of business administration. If a f

This scholarship will be in the amount of \$4,000.00 (\$1000.00 per year for 4 years). The female student is considering continuing her education at a four-year college or university, in the area of business administration, she is encouraged to apply for the scholarship. In order to maintain the scholarship from year to year, the student must show evidence of continuing in the field of business administration. And maintain a GPA of 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale. The student must provide a copy of their transcript prior to each year's payment.

### **Leroy C. Brown Scholarship**

Amount varies...there are 10 or more

Application deadline on or before **March 15, 2013**

This scholarship varies in amount from year to year but is approximately \$250.00 (one time). Annually, the Marguerite V. Brown Testamentary Trust will grant Leroy C. Brown Memorial Scholarships to high school seniors of the four Council Bluffs, Iowa Public High Schools. These schools are A.L., T.J., L.C., and ISD. Scholarships for the Lewis Central High School seniors are for any student pursuing a higher education.

### **Kevin Reedy Memorial Scholarship**

Amount: \$1,000 (one time)

Application deadline on or before **March 15, 2013**

Kevin Reedy, having graduated from the Lewis Central High School in May 2001, was enrolled as a freshman mathematics major at UNI, in Cedar Falls, Iowa. However, Kevin died on August 26, 2001, just 43 hours after moving into his dorm room. His sudden and unexpected death was attributed to Myocarditis, an inflammation of the heart presumed to be caused by Coxsackie B. Virus. As a result, Kevin never experienced the pleasure of attending college classes, an experience he eagerly looked forward to.

In high school, Kevin participated in sports and was an active motivator to fellow teammates. He was compassionate and caring to the sick and elderly, he was a blood and organ donor, and he achieved Life Scout status in the Boy Scouts of America.

Kevin was an 18-year old independent, responsible, loving son, brother, and friend. His smile will continue to shine on us forever. *Gina and Joe Reedy (Kevin's Parents)*

The Kevin Reedy Memorial Scholarship is a one time \$1,000.00 award given to a graduating senior from Lewis Central High School. The applicant must have been active in one or more school and/or community activities and/or organizations during high school. The applicant must plan to attend college the fall following high school graduation.

**Donna Hearty Scholarship**

Amount: \$1,000 (one time)

Application deadline on or before **March 15, 2013**

The Donna Hearty Scholarship is a scholarship of \$1,000.00 to be awarded to a Lewis Central graduate pursuing a higher education. Donna was a long time employee of Lewis Central Community School District. The applicant must have been active in one or more school and/or community activities and/or organizations during high school. The applicant must plan to attend an institution of higher learning the fall following high school graduation.

**Allen Family Scholarship**

Amount: \$1,000 (one time)

Application deadline on or before **March 15, 2013**

Students applying for this scholarship must be pursuing higher learning in the fields of music education or medicine.

**Pam Fox Scholarship**

Amount: \$300 (one time)

Application deadline on or before **March 15, 2013**

This scholarship is specifically for students pursuing a teaching endorsement in elementary education. Pam Fox was a long time employee of Lewis Central Community School District. The applicant must have been active in one or more school and/or community activities and/or organizations during high school. The applicant must plan to attend an institution of higher learning the fall following high school graduation.

Amount: \$400.00 (one time)

Application deadline on or before **March 15, 2013**
